- **Hens or pullets**
- **Keep four and cull four**

Pullets

- **Health and Vigor**
 - **No pullets will be used which show any symptoms of disease**
 - **Vigor should be shown through evidences of early body size, comb development, and bright alert eyes with feminine head**

Pullets

- **Health and Vigor**
- **Head**
 - **Should show the following characteristics: strong, moderately long, and well-filled in forward of the eyes to avoid any appearance of crow headedness**
 - **Face should be clean cut, smooth and free from wrinkles**
 - **Skin soft in texture**
 - **Comb of good substance and size and of good color**
 - **Eyes should be large, bright and prominent, and iris rich in color, the pupil distinctly and perfectly formed.**

Pullets

- **Health and Vigor**
- **Head**
- **Sexual maturity**
 - **Sexual maturity expressed in the development of comb and head**
 - **Early sexual maturity should not be at the expense of body development**
 - **Example: A rather small, poorly developed pullet that showed advanced sexual maturity might possibly be placed down second or third in a class of well developed pullets**

Pullets

- **Body conformation**
 - **Pullets should have an angular form**
 - **Body should be deep, broad, and well developed**
 - **Heart firth should be of ample circumference**
 - **Back should be broad and flat with the keel of good length**

- **Plumage condition and skin color**
 - **Pullets should be fully feathered with plumage of good quality**
 - **The shanks should show a good healthy color with no emphasis on intensity**

Pullets

- **Health and Vigor**

- **Plumage condition and skin color**
- **Feet and toes**
 - **Pullet should be well balanced on her legs, being neither knock-kneed nor bowlegged.**
 - **The feet and toes should be completely normal**
